New social elections to be scheduled on 12 March.

Pursuant to the law of 7 May 2018 (the “**Law**”) postponing the social elections to between 1 February and 31 March 2019 (see [Newsletter 16 May 2018](#)), a Ministerial Order of 3 December 2018 has fixed the social election date as 12 March 2019.

Where the organisation of work does not allow for the election to be held on 12 March 2019, the Order allows for companies to begin the election on 10 March 2019 at the earliest. In such case, the closing and the counting of the ballot must take place on 12 March 2019.

The process of the social elections is further described in the [Grand-Ducal Regulation of 11 September 2018](#) on electoral operations for the appointment of employee delegates.
