


Many Courses, Many Specialisations

| All Courses are offered for examination twice each year, in May and in October |
| Students take exams when they are ready |
| Each Module is examined by a 45 minutes written exam with a choice of questions |
| Exams are set and marked in London |
| Exams are given locally |
| Exam session takes place over one week |
| May re-take exam in any failed Module once |
| Must complete all studies within five years |

Cost 'Pay as you go': pay only when you study No fee to apply Fee structure: £740 Registration Fee (one time only) + £430 per Module Stop at Postgraduate Certificate in Laws = £740 + (5 x £430 per Module) = £2,890 ≈ €3,600 Stop at Postgraduate Diploma in Laws = £740 + (10 x £430 per Module) = £5,040 total ≈ €6,300 Master of Laws (LLM) = £740 + (16 x £430 per Module) = £7,620 total ≈ €9,500
